First, please note that Priority Points are not eCredits. These so-called Priority Points will be redeemable in Phase 2. Nevertheless, you will not be able to use them like traditional money. As Priority Points have no intrinsic value, they are not transferable, and can't be bought or sold. However, it is planned that the Priority Points can be redeemed for discounts when buying specific goods or services (the selection may vary, depending on the current range of products and services) within the myWorld network or myWorld partners. The so-called Priority Points are vouchers issued by Lyconet and myWorld. Therefore, the name change from eCredits Priority to Priority Points was carried out by Lyconet and myWorld.

The company behind eCredits does not belong to myWorld or Lyconet, but MyWorld and Lyconet are the preferred partners of eCredits. We hope we could provide some clarity. If you have any further questions, please let us know.
